



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Proposed Spot Rezoning Plan:

Aaron Cohn and Midland Middle Schools

Q Where can I find the presentation with the rezoning information and map?

Q Will any portion of the Garrett Pines subdivision be rezoned?

A Not at this time.

Q How do I apply for a hardship transfer to remain at Aaron Cohn?

A Once the window opens for school year 2019-2020, you can apply online and indicate that your student was rezoned for Midland and you wish to remain at Aaron Cohn.

Q Will my Hardship Transfer request be approved?

A Requests will be approved for rising 8th graders and their siblings who wish to remain at Aaron Cohn.

Q If I receive a Hardship Transfer approval, will I receive transportation?

A Hardship requests do not include transportation.



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Q Why weren't other middle schools considered for rezoning besides Aaron Cohn and Midland?

A They were. Aaron Cohn is at capacity and Midland is well below capacity.

Q What about the overflow of students at Mathews Elementary? Are there plans to relieve that school?

A Not at this time. We are observing growth patterns projected for all zones.

Q What supports will there be for students' transition to Midland Middle?

A The Midland Middle administration includes several layers of support to help guide students through academic, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities. Midland will plan a guided tour for all students transitioning to their school.

Q Will there be any supports ready for students with exceptionalities?

A Yes, we will provide the same resources that are currently being rendered.

Q When will the decision be finalized? And how will we be notified?

A April 15. We will send official notices to the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) of each student who is in the rezoned area.
