(Columbus, GA)-To help students with disabilities and their families obtain information, and plan for life after high school, the Muscofee County School District, Goodwill, Columbus State University, and Columbus Technical College will host a **Transition Fair** on Thursday, March 31, 2011, at Columbus Technical College, 928 Manchester Expressway, in the Patrick Hall Student Center from 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Families may ask questions of private agencies, public agencies, and businesses that provide a variety of transition support services. Because research shows transition is most successful when started before students enter high school, the target audience includes students in grades 8-12 with various disabilities, which includes students with 504 plans.
