Hardship Request Notice

(Columbus, GA)-The time period to request a hardship transfer for the 2013-2014 school year is open. **The deadline to make a hardship transfer request is May 17, by 5:00 p.m.** Parents may pick up a hardship form at their child's current/assigned school or the Central Registration office in the Muscogee County Public Education Center, 2960 Macon Road. All completed hardship forms must be returned to Central Registration by 5:00 P.M. on Friday, May 17, to be considered for approval. The assigned school principal does not need to sign the hardship transfer form. Parents should receive the results of their request by the end of June 2013.

Approximately 10,000 assignment letters were mailed to parents with 2013-2014 school assignments. Not all students receive letters. Letters are mailed to parents of rising 6th and 9th grade students as well as those students who have an address change during this school year that results in a different school assignment for 13-14. In addition, with the middle school rezoning to accommodate the opening of Aaron Cohn Middle School in August, all 6th and 7th grade students who currently attend Blackmon Road Middle School, Fort Middle School and Midland Middle School were mailed letters for clarification of the 2013-2014 school assignment.
