(Columbus, GA)-The annual National Signing Day for Scholars ceremony for graduating seniors is Monday, May 5, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. at the George Washington Carver High School (Auditorium), located at 3100 Eighth Street. Approximately 150 seniors who are scheduled to graduate in Columbus in 2014 earned academic scholarships. Last Spring 125 area seniors earned over \$15,000,000 in grants and scholarships.

The Muscogee County School District in partnership with area private schools, St. Anne-Pacelli, Brookstone, Calvary Christian and our proud sponsor Columbus Regional Healthcare System plans the annual event. Dr. Frank Brown, retired President of Columbus State University, conceived the idea to honor our Columbus students who have excelled in academics.

- No athletic scholarships, sorority/fraternity scholarships, civic scholarships, nor Hope scholarships are considered.
